St. Rose Philippine Duchesne - New Church Ground Breaking Ceremony

1st of September 2024, twenty (20) years after the creation of St. Rose as a parish, we commemorate this occasion with the groundbreaking ceremony for the construction of a New Church. Today is a grace-filled moment for all parishioners of St. Rose. Our hearts are full of gratitude for all who were part of Our Faith, Our Future, and Our Parish journey. We appreciate all Pastors who served here, the present team of Priests, and all parishioners, both the past and the present. This groundbreaking is more than just moving dirt, as Bp. Dolan said in his homily. The bigger groundbreaking is the inward conversion of the heart, and the readings point to this theme: 1.) Moses encourages the people to abide in God and with one another and to stay in God as they prepare to enter the promised land, 2.) Groundbreaking reminder from the Psalms: The JUST will live in the presence of the Lord, 3.) The groundbreaking challenge of St. James: To be doers of the WORD and not hearers only, 4.) Jesus in the Gospel nails the meaning of the inward conversion of the heart: Nothing that enters a person from outside can make the person unclean, but the one that comes from within, from the HEART that defiles the person. Today, we can also experience a groundbreaking *moment* in our lives if we are willing to turn and move the dirt and *live just lives*, not in the future but now, in the present, TO LIVE IN THE PRESENCE OF THE LORD.



Groundbreaking

Congratulations to everyone on the historical event of the groundbreaking of your new church. The ceremony was attended by over 300 people on Sunday, September 1, 2024.

Bishop John Dolan and Father Bing Colasito officiated the ceremony with a Scripture reading, a blessing of the site of the future cornerstone, and a lowering and burying of the time capsule which contained a newspaper from the day, a rosary, the event program, and a set of construction documents.

What happens now? We are awaiting issuance of the construction permit from Maricopa County and final approval from the Diocese of Phoenix. The latter approval will be finalized on September 25th, and the County permit should be issued in October. Our lender is in place and is prepared to fund the construction costs that exceed our cash on hand. We ask that you continue to pray for a construction start date in October. The builder has indicated that the project will take about 13 months, which possibly means a dedication Mass around Christmas 2025.


Baptism Preparation Classes


